- Maintain, repair, test and install electrical motors, generators, alternators, industrial storage batteries and hydraulic and pneumatic electrical control systems
- Read and interpret drawing, blueprint schematics and electrical code specifications to determine layout of industrial electrical equipment installations.
- Test electrical and electronic equipment for continuity current, voltage and resistance.
- Maintain repair and test switch gear, transformers, switch board meters, regulators and reactors
- Troubleshoot, maintain and repair industrial, electrical and electronic control systems and other related devices
- Interpret electrical code specifications
- Conduct preventive maintenance programs and keep maintenance records

Requirements:
